## About this Project...

Malnutrition, HIV/AIDS, malaria and tuberculosis are widespread in the Muheza region of Tanzania; the average life expectancy is just 46 years. The Church in Tanzania is responding to this great need by working with communities giving primary healthcare and health education. Money donated through USPG goes to supporting the general work of Teule Hospital – a large district hospital in Muheza. Teule works with the district

medical officer to promote health in the area. It facilitates the village health programme, together with other non-governmental agencies, and supports the implementation of an extended programme of immunization. Teule Hospital serves a population of 280,000, mostly subsistence farmers and small traders. Responding to HIV/AIDS is a priority. The hospital also runs a training school for both general nurses and midwives.
